### **The Holy Name of Jesus, the Epiphany, and the Baptism**

***Epiphany** means manifestation. The Epiphany is a great Feast as it renews the joy caused us by the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ. The Church celebrates the manifestation of Our Lord to the world; after being revealed to the Magi who came from the East to adore Him. The Epiphany is an affirmation of universal salvation.*

*In January we also celebrate the Feast of the **Most Holy Name of Jesus**, taken from the Hebrew Joshua or Yehoshuah, meaning "Yahweh is salvation" or "Yahweh will save". We pray that God will plant into our heart a deeper love for our Lord Jesus Christ. During the Middle Ages, the Name of Jesus was written: IHESUS. The emblem IHS contains the first and last letters of the Holy Name.*

*With the **Baptism of the Lord**, the Church shifts from Advent & Christmas back to Ordinary Time (Green) as we begin the Public Life of Jesus, following Year B and the Gospel according to Mark. This is interrupted with Ash Wednesday and the season of Lent & Easter in February.*
